## Basic Fire Safety

This is a course that will prepare participants to deal with fire-related hazards. It delivers knowledge on fire safety awareness including how to prevent incidents, prepare for such and respond in cases of fire-related emergencies.

## Basic Fire Safety

### What you will gain

The course teaches hands-on skills using highly interactive learning methods. On completion participants will:

- be able to recognise life-threatening situations
- be a competent first aider able to offer vital assistance during emergencies

### Who should attend

- General public
- School and college students
- Workers and employees of companies, organizations (NGO and Government), corporations, industries and factories
- Fire safety officers and fire marshals/wardens
- Members of Safety, Health and Wellness Committees
- Staff members of uniformed and disciplined services

### Topics covered

- Fire and firefighting history
- Causes and classification of fires
- Fire prevention measures at the workplace
- Fire suppression and fighting equipment
- Statutory requirements
- Evacuation procedures in fire Response
- First Aid for burns and scalds
- Practical use of firefighting appliances

### Duration

1 day or 2 days if offered together as part of Basic First Aid course

### Certification

Successful participants will receive a Kenya Red Cross Society Certificate of Completion.
